


### SCIENCE SUPER STARS

In C7 we have been enjoying learning about Weathering, Erosion and Deposition in our Science lessons. In week 1 we carried out an experiment with damp sand to create landforms and used water to create the rivers and rain and blew through straws to create wind to see how the sand was moved to show the three processes. All students had a turn at engaging with the learning and performing tasks set out in the method.

We also planned, created and reflected on a landform diorama. Students were given ideas and had discussions with a teacher about what landforms they wanted to create; mountains, valleys, desert, island, river, plains or plateaus. Students used tissue paper, cardboard, wadding, cellophane, material, sand and animals to create their own scene. It was impressive to see how engaged Mason, Tammy and Oliver were in creating their own ideas with the supplies presented to them. River, Nabil, Finley and Faith were all able to either point to ideas or give a word or phrase to allow the teacher to scaffold and build on their personal ideas. The final dioramas are amazing and show knowledge and understanding of the Science content taught this Semester
